**§ 323-1. Emergency use only; interference prohibited.**

No person shall, without authority from the Chief of the Fire Department, open, pull or otherwise cause to sound an alarm, or interfere with a signal box, wire or anything connected with the fire alarm apparatus except in cases of fire or related emergency.

**§ 323-2. Violations and penalties.**

For the purpose of this chapter, the penalty for violation of any provision of this bylaw shall be a fine of not more than \$200 for each day said violation exists, unless otherwise specified in the General Laws of the Commonwealth.
