ARTICLE I

Class II and III License Holder Regulations

[Adopted 5-11-2005 SATM, Art. 56 (Article XV, Sec. 5, of the 1973 General Bylaws)]

§ 459-1. Fire and safety inspection.

Prior to license issuance or renewal the fire department will conduct a fire and safety inspection. Any violations that are noted must be corrected prior to the renewal or issuance of the license.

§ 459-2. Storage of flammable or combustible liquids.

- A. No storage of flammable or combustible liquids in quantities greater than five gallons will be allowed without a permit from the fire department. Applications are available at Fire Headquarters.
- B. No storage of flammable or combustible gases in quantities greater than 40 cubic feet will be allowed without a permit from the fire department. Applications are available at Fire Headquarters.
